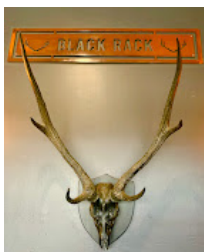

These cards can be used at all participating United outlets.

We are included on the UP Community list of clubs and members can now apply for either a digital or plastic UP Community fuel discount card.

You will receive a 2 cent per litre discount at participating United service stations and a 2 cent per litre rebate will be provided to the Kilcoy Golf Club. This means you'll enjoy great savings on your fuel, whilst supporting the Club every time you fill up at a participating United service station.

## GOLF ETIQUETTE AND RULES

### Safety

Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing.

Players should not play until the players in front are out of range.

Players should always alert green staff nearby or ahead when they are about to make a stroke that might endanger them.

If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is "fore".
